- 1 Visit holmescc.edu and click on "Enroll Now."

- 5 Create your Login ID and PIN.
- 6 After you successfully complete each portion and submit your application, you will receive a "SUCCESS!" message.*
- 7 Select the "Enroll Now" link below your "SUCCESS!" message. This action will provide instructions on how to set up your MyHolmes account.
- 8 Once you have set up your MyHolmes Account, log into "Enroll Now" using your provided student email address and new password.
- 9 Click the link to complete Orientation in Step 3 of "Enroll Now."
- 10 If your program requires separate admission (Nursing, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Massage Therapy, Physical Therapy Assistant, or Surgical Technology) you may now apply through MyHolmes.
